In accordance to the provision of Article47 m paragraph 1 of the Act of 13 June 2019 on economic activity in the scope of manufacturing and trade in explosives, weapons, ammunition and products and technology for military or police use (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 1545 and of 2021, item 1329), the Chief Commander of the Police is obliged to set up the National Contact Point for Alarm and Signal Weapons.

The tasks of the above-mentioned Contact Point include:

- 1) performing the obligation of the Chief Commander in the Police with regard to keeping a register of alarm and signal weapons,
- 2) registering the results of controls carried out by the authorized entity,
- 3) providing contact points established in other Member States of the European Union, Member States of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) which are parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area or the Swiss Confederation, at their request, information from the register of alarm and signal weapons, information on the results of the checks referred to in Article 47j(4) and to request such information,
- 4) recording of entrepreneurs' declarations on:
  - fulfilling the requirements, referred to in Article 47a, for producing a specific type or model of alarm and signal weapon - once a year, counting from the date of issuing the certificate for alarm and signal weapons;
  - the quantity of alarm and signal weapons of a specific type and model manufactured and placed on the market during the last accounting period.
